Dear Local Resident/Business,

As the date of the 2017 Ikano Bank Robin Hood Marathon and Half Marathon approaches we are writing to tell you that the event is coming to your area, and of the traffic management measures which may affect you.

As organisers, we appreciate there will be some disruption, which we hope you understand is unavoidable when staging such a large mass participation event and we thank you for your patience and cooperation in advance of race day.

General Information

Start Time: 09.30 from Victoria Embankment

Road closures

We have worked very closely with Nottingham City Council and the Park Estate to agree a full traffic management system which will be safe for the runners and cause the minimum amount of disruption to residents and other road users. However, there will be times when some roads will be closed to traffic and parking restrictions will be in place, which are necessary to host such a large road race. If you are affected and need to be somewhere on the day please plan your journey in advance and if possible can we ask you consider moving your car to a nearby street which is not affected.
