We are the Nottingham based Belters choir and we sing songs with harmonies from around the world, from European folk to traditional and modern gospel sounds from Iran, Africa and the United States.

Once again, we are pleased to invite you to join us or listen from afar to 'Songs in the Tunnel', which is taking place on Saturday 14th July, 7.30 – 10pm in the Park Tunnel.

In 2018, as we are marking 100 years since the first women won the right to vote, we are fundraising for Women's Aids Integrated Services, a Nottingham based organisation which supports women to build a new life following their experience of domestic abuse. Tickets are available on the night - £5.

We have agreement again from the Park Estate Committee, City Council, and the necessary authorities to make the event work for all concerned. We have arranged for the Tunnel to be cleaned for the event. We are aware that there is no parking in the Tunnel Road area or in the Park except for disabled drivers and drop offs.

We are also aware that the Tunnel is used regularly and we will keep a passage clear. Anyone who comes through the Tunnel and enjoys the concert will not be asked for a ticket, but may be asked for a voluntary donation!
